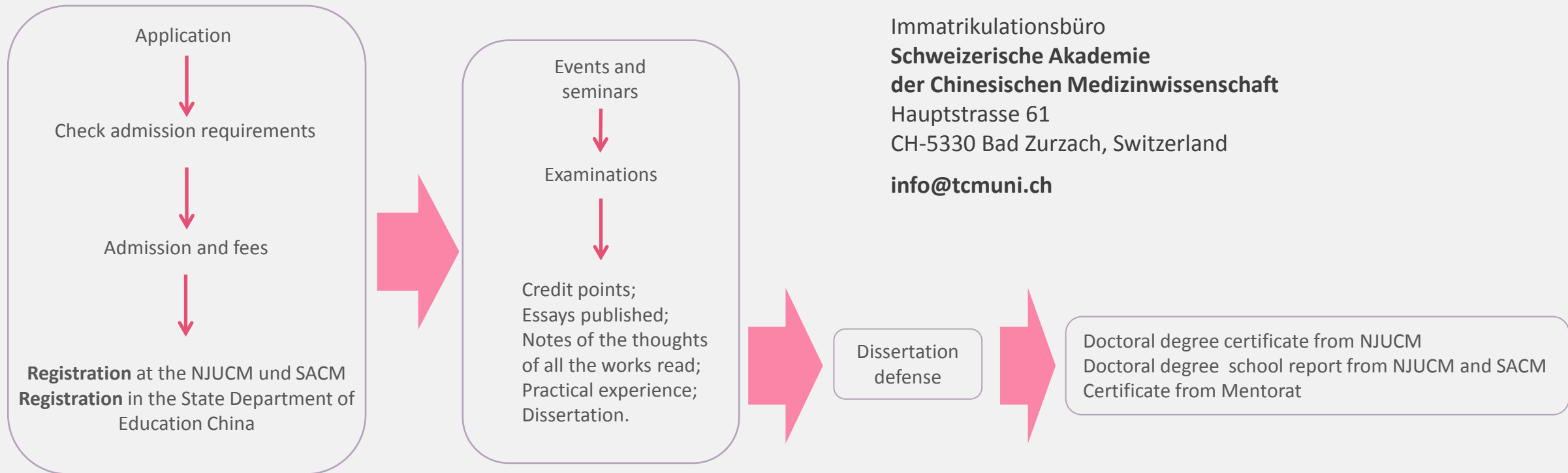

Education Goal

We aim to train students to TCM specialists with passion to Chinese traditional culture, good doctors' ethics, solid TCM knowledge and high professional skills, strong ability for clinic research, able to cope with common and difficult cases in his proficiency, to inherit TCM tradition with innovative spirit. They will be able to apply Jingfang in the clinical practice and to promote the Chinese traditional medicine culture around the world.

This course lasts three years, based on part-time system. Those who pass the examinations and doctor dissertation will be awarded doctor degrees by the Academy Committee of the Nanjing University of Chinese Traditional Medicine.



Requirement of Candidates

1. Applicants must already have a degree of Bachelor of Medicine or Master of Medicine with more than 6 years of TCM clinical practice;
2. They must own license as TCM practitioner in the living country
3. Candidates from the China Mainland, Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan are excluded in the enrollment.



General Requirements

1. Learn to appreciate and experience the Chinese traditional culture and TCM classics;
2. Explore tradition and pursue innovation, theory is applied to the need of the local folks;
3. Research and modern approach in clinical practices on the bases of Shanghan Lun (Treatise of Cold Damage Disorder) and Jin Gui Yao Lue (Essential Prescriptions from the Golden Cabinet).

To master I Jing (Classic of Changes), Tao De Jing (Laozi) and Huandi Neijing (Esoteric Scripture of the Yellow Emperor) in order to understand the TCM theory of harmonic co-existence of human and nature - the core of Jingfang theory, To explore and appreciate the Chinese tradition and culture as an essential part of the Chinese medicine,

To study systematically the TCM masterpieces of Shanghan Lun and Jin Gui Yao Lue, To keep well-informed about the newest development of medical theory and clinic in the country and in the world; to be able to read TCM science documents in foreign languages, To achieve the requested semester credit points, to pass the examination and doctoral dissertation.



Learning Methods

The study plan is carried out in accordance with the standard of the Nanjing University of Chinese Traditional Medicine..

Semester study, subject research and degree dissertation have to be accompanied by the appointed tutors.

Semester study can be accomplished in Switzerland or in other countries. Dissertation proposal, dissertation defense and related research, as well as Chinese medical culture tour are to be accomplished in Nanjing and other places in China.

The study lasts three years with six semesters: 1-2 intensive courses each semester, and every intensive course lasts 1-2 weeks – all together 630 hours.



Semester Plan

For doctor degree students, the study mainly consists of courses and lectures under the guidance of two international tutors.



Clinical Practice, academic publications and activities

Under the guidance of the doctoral supervisors, the students should take part of clinic work and study tours no less than 6 months, and accomplish summery work with no less than 50 clinical cases, as well as accept the competence assessment from the institute he is enrolled.

Academic public:

to write at least four academic articles two semester papers during the study semesters, – at least two of them have to be published in professional journals.

Academic activities :

Participate actively in academic seminars and congresses, have the ability to host academic discussion and write thesis based on his own dissertation.



Completion of examinations

Requirements of Doctoral Dissertation:

the theme of the dissertation should be clinic practice relevant; the research conclusion should be significant to the clinical work - both in theory and practice, showing special characteristics of the chosen study. The dissertation should present his competence of applying theory to solve problems in clinical work and research.

Dissertation Defense:

The dissertation defense takes place only after the Ph.D. students accomplish 35 semester credit points and the above mentioned requirements. The successful Ph.D. candidates will be awarded with doctor degree by the Academy Committee of Nanjing University of Chinese Traditional Medicine.
